As he moves in the excavator continues to remove material.  Supervisor not paying proper attention, possibly on his phone. Looks up to see what's happening and moves forward to tell Banksman to move away.  L (shouting): "hey, stand back"	Team members are not behaving appropriately for the level of risk involved here. 	Cable strike by excavator.  Loud noise and a flash.  Operator and others are fine, but banksman is hit by the flashover from the strike  Banksman shouts in pain and falls back, and film goes dark.
